

KEY DATA ON HPV AND HPV-RELATED CANCERS

India has a population of 511.4 million women aged 15 years and older who are at risk of developing cervical cancer.

Current estimates (Globocan 2022) indicate that every year 127,526 women are diagnosed with cervical cancer and 79,906 die from the disease.

Cervical cancer ranks as the 2nd most frequent cancer among women in India and the 2nd most frequent cancer among women between 15 and 44 years of age. About 5.0% of women in the general population are estimated to harbour cervical HPV-16/18 infection at a given time, and 83.2% of invasive cervical cancers are attributed to HPVs 16 or 18.

- HPV infections are very common, with 8 out of 10 people getting infected at some point. HPV vaccination can prevent 90% of related cancers.

Eksangh Foundation's Initiative

- We are organizing an HPV vaccination program for girls aged 9-26.*
- Girls aged 9-14 will need 2 doses at 0 to 6-12 months, while those aged 15-26 will require 3 doses 0, 2 and 6 months.*



Target Reach & Expected Impact

- Our program aims to vaccinate **HUNDREDS** of girls, significantly reducing HPV-related cancer cases in the community.
- We will be targeting ALL schools and colleges in our area as well as other near by area schools and colleges.

- Monthly Vaccination Camps first one being on October 23, 2024



HPV Informational 'Street Play'

Educating Communities: HPV Street Play

- To spread awareness about the importance of HPV vaccination, the Eksangh Foundation will organize an informational street play. This performance will be targeted at parents and guardians to help them understand the significance of vaccinating their daughters to prevent cervical cancer. The street play will be performed in local languages, ensuring that the message resonates with rural communities.*
- The goal is to engage the community in a culturally relevant way, addressing myths and concerns around the HPV vaccine, and empowering parents to protect their daughters' health.*

Vaccination Requirements & Costs

HPV Vaccination Cost-Per Girl

Ages 9-14: Two shots, Total cost ₹2,500 OR (\$31) per girl

2-Shot Regimen:

Ages 15-26: Three shots, total cost ₹3,750 (\$46)

3-Shot Regimen:

Parents share is 25% of the total cost.
